Position Type: Contracted, exempt employee. Paid on a salaried basis.

Qualifications:

- A bachelor's degree from an accredited postsecondary college or university required
- TEA and/or ACSI certification required or willingness to complete within a specified timeframe
- Two or more years of classroom experience preferred
- Musical experience required; orff, kodaly, solfege experience preferred

It is expected that all SCS staff members will:

- Seek God first and prioritizes the needs of students
- See families as partners, involving them as often as possible.
- Demonstrate the qualities of:
 - Enthusiasm, as a self-starter, encourager, and life-long learner.
 - Professionalism
 - Punctuality and consistency

 - Use research-based, proven pedagogy to positively affect student learning
 - Collaboration with all stakeholders, especially colleagues
 - Flexibility, as a team player and in risk-taking. Resilience & perseverance are expected.
 - Integrity in all personal and professional matters
 - Kindness, sensitivity, and grace with all stakeholders
 - Spiritual Maturity - to lead and disciple the next generation
- Maintain a personal appearance that is attributed to a role model of cleanliness, modesty, and good taste consistent with school expectations.
- Represent the school in a favorable and professional manner at all times.
- Follow Matthew 18 in dealing with conflict with any stakeholder.
- Understand the physical/emotional development of children—particularly at the age level of the children being taught
- Demonstrate effective written & oral communication skills. Respond to parent communication in a timely manner - in person, via email, or on the phone.



As a Music Teacher, you will

- Organize and prepare students for 4 programs per year - Veteran's Day (PK3-6th), Christmas (PK3-6th), Spring Showcase (PK3-6th), Graduation (6th)
- Differentiate instruction to meet diverse learner needs
- Instill a Biblical love of music, reminding students of the place of music in scripture
- Balance teaching music basics and foundational skills with preparing program material. Students should learn to play basic instruments (bucket drums, boomwhackers, recorders, orff instruments, etc.) and also learn to sing. Sightreading can be developed over time as the program grows.

Work Schedule:

- **190-day contract:** 180 classroom instructional days plus 10 in-service, professional development, and/or work days.
- **Daily hours:** 30 minutes before instructional day begins (7:45am) until 15 minutes after student dismissal (3:45pm) (Friday staff devotions begin at 7:30am).
- Twice monthly **staff meetings** are on the first and third Wednesday from 3:45 - 4:45pm.
- Attend and participate in required **school functions:** open houses, Christmas program, spring program, graduation, one PTF sponsored social, one PTF sponsored parent education program, and one of the monthly PTF meetings.
